The Mama Emilienne Tchatchueng Scholarship has been established by her family in loving memory of Mama Emilienne Tchatchueng (1957-2012) who passed away suddenly in Bangangte, Cameroon in 2012.

Mama Emilienne Tchatchueng Biography

Mama Emilienne Tchatchueng, Tsemo's wife was born in Company-Foumbot, Cameroon in 1957. Affectionately called Ma'a Emie, Mama Emilienne was the first born of a large family of thirteen children. After a brief childhood in Foumbot with her parents, Ma'a Emie continued her primary and secondary education in Douala at the High School of Girls in New Bell where she received her first degree (BEPC). She then embraces technical studies, mainly in sewing and wonderfully excels. It is by sewing that Ma'a Emie establishes her reputation as a great dressmaker in Sangmélina (1973-1992), Bafoussam (1992-1993), Nkongsamba (1993-1995) and Bangangté (1995-2012).

Ma'a Emie was self-taught, with an unlimited fashion models inspiration and an exceptional talent. She realized a vast number of fashion cloths, costumes, lingerie, bedding sheets and curtains, as well as diversified modern and traditional outfits for a variety of customers (women, men and children). Ma'a Emie's creative talent always exceeded her customer's expectations. Her passion for sewing art led her to establish wherever she resided, an apprenticeship workroom where she trained many apprentices to this art.

Christian, loving wife, caring mother and sister, charitable, Ma'a Emie had the opportunity to raise their three children out of the four. She also lovely raised many other children.

Ma'a Emie also loved cooking, breeding and farming. Unfortunately, her health deteriorated over time and she suddenly passed away on May

17, 2012 at the age of 55 years, leaving behind her husband (Papa Albert Tsemo), their three children and several grandchildren. The most important legacy of Ma'a Emie is her love for the family and the motivation for the perpetual quest of academic excellence.

Tsemo's Family and Mr. Patrick Kamdem, Vice Chair of the Foundation's Scholarship Committee and Mama Emilienne's direct cousin.

Description

Mama Emilienne Tchatchueng Scholarship is awarded four times a year through the Cameroon-Canadian Foundation and it is for undergraduates, graduates and postgraduates students who pursue their studies (full-time) in any discipline in Canadian or Cameroonian universities, colleges and institutes.

Eligibility Criteria

The Mama Emilienne Tchatchueng Scholarship is open to all Canadians, Cameroonians, Permanent Residents and International students engage in undergraduate, graduate or postgraduate study in any field, in Canada or in Cameroon. Applicants must be enrolled full-time in a Canadian or Cameroonian university, college and/or institute for incoming and continuing Diploma, Bachelor, Masters or Doctoral programs.

Evaluation Criteria

The award will be based on excellence and high academic achievements, the need, good aptitudes and personal qualities.

Application Procedures

Applicants must complete the attached application form and the required documents and send them by mail or email to the Cameroon-Canadian Foundation (see above contact information). If sent by email, documents should be in pdf form. Hard copies must be sent later to the Foundation if the Scholarship is awarded.

- One letter of reference from professor who has a deep knowledge of your ability, work and accomplishments. (Reference letter should be addressed to the Cameroon-Canadian Foundation and in support of your application for the Mama Emilienne Tchatchueng Scholarship).

Important Notice

Applicants are advised to collect and submit all their application documents in one envelope and must ensure that it is received by the Cameroon-Canadian Foundation before the dateline.

Award notification

The Scholarship Board Committee of the Cameroon-Canadian Foundation will review all applications received and advise all applicants of the outcome in less than two weeks after the Dateline.

Payment Procedures

Following the results and notification, the Foundation will contact the winners in order to pay directly the tuitions fees to the designated university, college or institute. **Please note that, if the winner have already paid his/her tuition fees, the proposed scholarship will be awarded to next candidate in the short list which have such need and fulfil the requirements.** The names and pictures of the Scholarship recipient will be on the Foundation's website and if feasible, a ceremony will be held in Canada and/or in Cameroon to recognize recipients.
